

PRIVACY POLICY – UPDATED 07/02/2022

St. Gabriel's Foundation is committed to protecting your privacy and developing technology that gives you the most powerful and safe online experience. This Statement of Privacy applies to the St. Gabriel's Foundation Website (www.stgabriels.ie) and governs data collection and usage. By using the St. Gabriel's Foundation website, you consent to the data practices described in this statement.

Collection of your Personal Information

St. Gabriel's Foundation collects personally identifiable information, such as your e-mail address, name, home or work address or telephone number for the purposes of registering your details with St. Gabriel's Foundation or as a participant/registrant for an event organised by St. Gabriel's Foundation. Except to the extent required in some circumstances e.g. special dietary requirements, St. Gabriel's Foundation does not request any other personal information.

There is also information about your computer hardware and software that is automatically collected by St. Gabriel's Foundation. This information can include: your IP address, browser type, domain names, access times and referring Web site addresses. This information is used by St. Gabriel's Foundation for the operation of the service, to maintain quality of the service, and to provide general statistics regarding use of St. Gabriel's Foundation Website.

St. Gabriel's Foundation encourages you to review the privacy statements of Websites you choose to link to through St. Gabriel's Foundation so that you can understand how those Websites collect, use and share your information. St. Gabriel's Foundation is not responsible for the privacy statements or other content on Web sites outside of St. Gabriel's Foundation.

Use of your Personal Information

St. Gabriel's Foundation collects and uses your personal information to operate St. Gabriel's Foundation Web site www.stgabriels.ie and deliver the services you have requested. St. Gabriel's Foundation also uses your personally identifiable information to inform you of other products or services available from St. Gabriel's Foundation through its main website (www.stgabriels.ie)

St. Gabriel's Foundation may also contact you via surveys to conduct research about your opinion of the sector, current services or of potential new services that may be offered.

St. Gabriel's Foundation does not sell, rent or lease its customer lists to third parties. In addition, St. Gabriel's Foundation may share data with trusted partners to help us perform statistical analysis, send you email or postal mail. All such third parties are prohibited from using your personal information except in their provision of these services to St. Gabriel's Foundation, and they are required to maintain the confidentiality of your information.

St. Gabriel's Foundation keeps track of the Websites and pages our customers visit within our website in order to determine what services are most frequently used. These results are used to deliver customized content and promotion within St. Gabriel's Foundation to clients whose behaviour indicates that they are interested in a particular subject area.

St. Gabriel's Foundation Website will disclose your personal information, without notice, only if required to do so by law or in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to: (a) conform to the edicts of the law or comply with legal process served on St. Gabriel's Foundation or the site; (b) protect and defend the rights or property of St. Gabriel's Foundation; and, (c) act under exigent circumstances to protect the personal safety of users of St. Gabriel's Foundation, or the public.

Use of Cookies

St. Gabriel's Foundation Website uses "cookies" to help you personalize your online experience. A cookie is a text file that is placed on your hard disk by a Web page server. Cookies cannot be used to run programs or deliver viruses to your computer. Cookies are uniquely assigned to you, and can only be read by a web server in the domain that issued the cookie to you.

One of the primary purposes of cookies is to provide a convenience feature to save you time. The purpose of a cookie is to tell the Web server that you have returned to a specific page. For example, if you personalize St. Gabriel's Foundation pages, or register with St. Gabriel's Foundation site or services, a cookie helps St. Gabriel's Foundation to recall your specific information on subsequent visits. This simplifies the process of recording your personal information, such as billing addresses, shipping addresses, and so on. When you return to the same St. Gabriel's Foundation Website, the information you previously provided can be retrieved, so you can easily use the features that you customized.

You have the ability to accept or decline cookies. Most Web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies if you prefer. If you choose to decline cookies, you may not be able to fully experience the interactive features of St. Gabriel's Foundation services or Websites you visit.

Security of your Personal Information

St. Gabriel's Foundation takes all reasonable steps to secure your personal information from unauthorized access, use or disclosure and secures the personally identifiable information you provide on computer servers in a controlled, secure environment, protected from unauthorized access, use or disclosure. When personal information (such as a credit card number) is transmitted to other Websites, it is protected through the use of encryption, such as the Secure Socket Layer (SSL) protocol.
